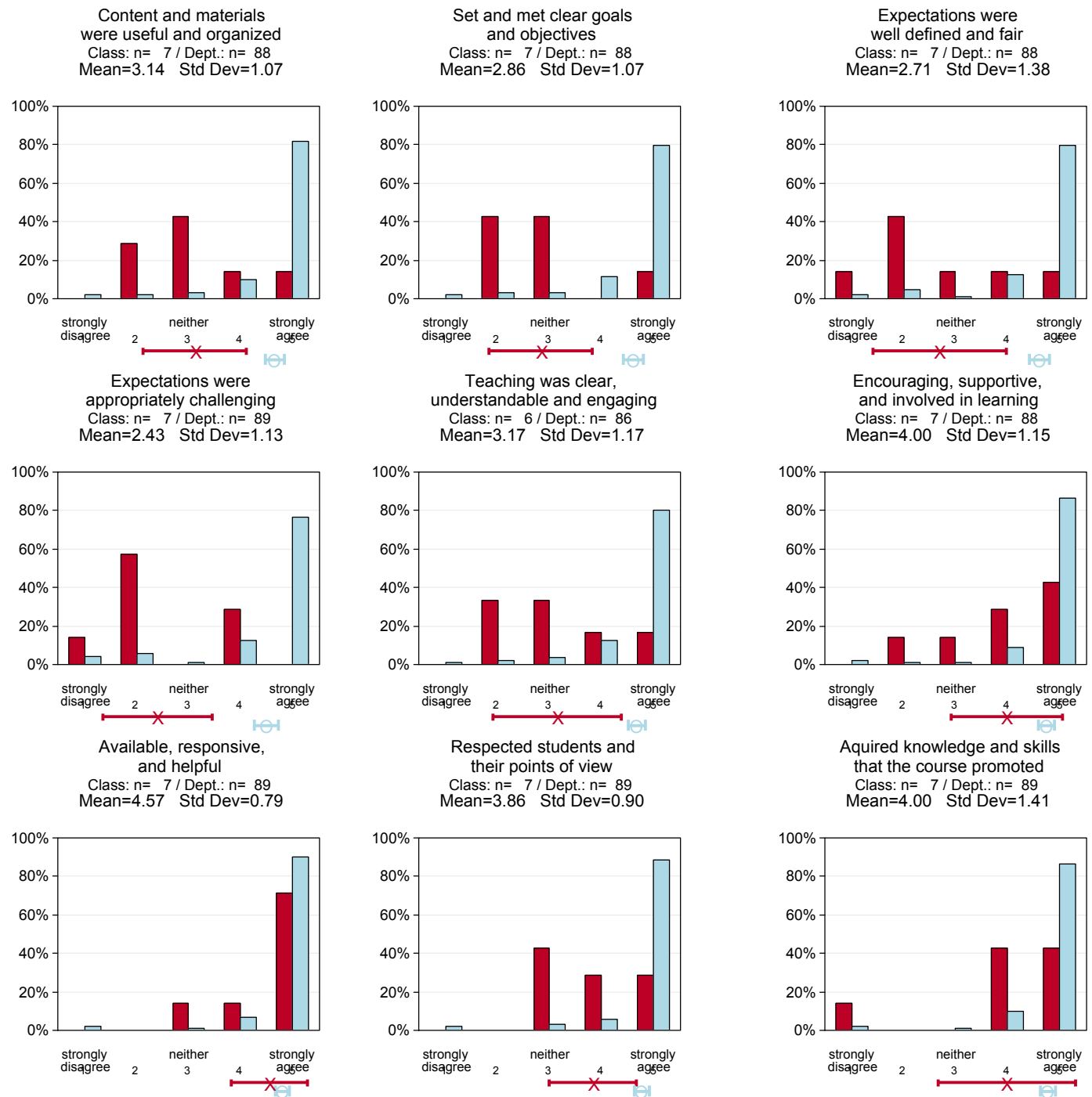

■ —o— mean and 95% C.I. results for the department's graduate courses



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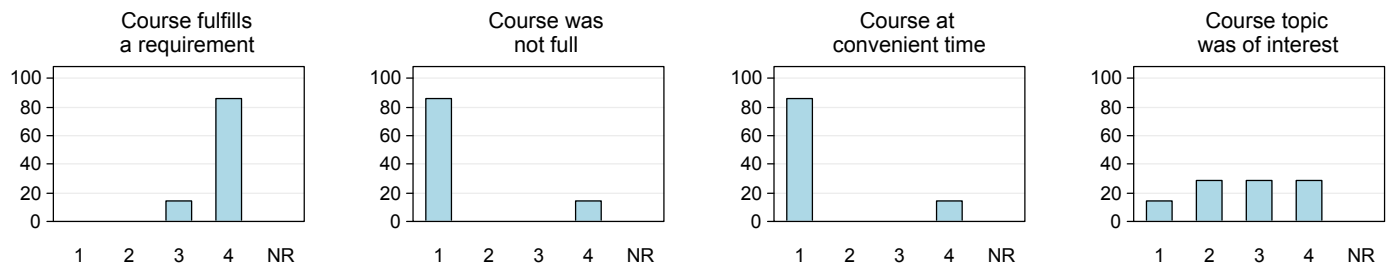
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Reasons for taking course
